

# **Pattern & Instructions**

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## **Doll Hammock**

Thank you for downloading this project. I hope you will enjoy making a hammock (or two).

#### Materials needed:

- Cotton fabric
- Ribbon (you can make it yourself by folding a 1.5" fabric strip in half, open it up again fold the outer edges towards the fold in the center and fold it again. Sew along the long edge to finish the ribbon); I used store bought one about 3/8" wide.
- ▶ Wooden rings, about 2" in diameter

Cut:

- > 2x fabric rectangles (28" x 18") (I used a pillowcase)
- 2x ribbons (handmade or store bought) (35")
- 2x ribbons (40")

If you want to make a larger hammock, adjust the fabric rectangle and ribbon length accordingly.

### Instructions



#### Materials needed:

- Cotton fabric
- Ribbon (you can make it yourself by folding a 1.5" fabric strip in half, open it up again fold the outer edges towards the fold in the center and fold it again. Sew along the long edge to finish the ribbon); I used store bought one about 3/8" wide.
- ▶ Wooden rings, about 2" in diameter



Put the two fabric rectangles right sides together and sew along the outer edges, leaving a turning hole on one of the shorter sides. Clip the corners.





Turn the fabric inside out.





Fold the shorter edges over, about 1", and pin them in place.





Sew the folded over fabric in place on both sides, about 3/4" from the edge, making sure to leave an opening for the ribbon to go through. This step also closes the turning hole.



Cut 2x ribbons to 35" and tie them to the wooden rings, by folding the ribbon in half and pulling the open ends through the loop.





Now pull one of the open ends of the ribbon through the ribbon tunnel.



Tie a knot with the other end of the ribbon and hide the knot in the ribbon tunnel. Repeat for the other side of the hammock.



Cut 2x 40" ribbons and tie them to the other side of the wooden ring in the same way as before. These will be the ribbons to tie up the hammock.





Now your hammock is ready to be mounted.
